An Act to reimburse the Inland Fisheries and Game Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 11 of chapter 131 of the general laws is hereby amended by adding the following
- 2 sentence to the end of the section:-
- The inland fisheries and game fund shall be reimbursed annually from the general fund
- 4 for all loss of revenue for any fishing or hunting license provided at a discount and for any
- 5 license provided free of charge.
