### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to hunting near a dwelling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word "thereof" the following words:-

3 ", provided that a person may hunt with a bow and arrow from an elevated tree stand not

4 less than 250 feet from any dwelling in use except as authorized by the owner or occupant

5 thereof".
