Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 39A of Chapter 129 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
- 2 Edition, is amended by striking the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following:-
- 4 This section shall not apply to a publicly or privately owned zoological park, a publicly
- 5 owned animal pound, a privately operated animal shelter or rescue organization, to persons
- 6 selling, exchanging or otherwise transferring the offspring of their personally owned animals, or
- 7 to horse or cattle auctions.
