## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to ensure consistency in climate adaptation management planning.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection (a) of section 10 of chapter 21N of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following words:- Upon the adoption of the
- 3 state plan, all certificates, licenses, permits, authorizations, grants, financial obligations, projects,
- 4 actions and approvals for any proposed projects, uses or activities in and by a state agency or
- 5 state authority shall be consistent, to the maximum extent practicable, with the plan.
