**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to equal opportunity for craft cooperatives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 20 of
2 chapter 55 of the acts of 2017, is hereby amended in the definition of “craft marijuana cultivator
3 cooperative” by striking out the words “to marijuana establishments but not to consumers” and
4 inserting in place thereof the following words: “to those entities or individuals authorized by law
5 or regulation to receive such deliveries.”
