In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)

An Act relative to state contracting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 27H of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following sentence:- No agreement or contract providing for the cleaning and
4 maintenance of public buildings or space rented by any state executive, legislative or judicial
5 department, office, commission, board, bureau, institution, regional or independent authority or
6 any instrumentality thereof shall be entered into or given unless the contract or agreement
7 contains a stipulation requiring prescribed rates of wages, as determined by the commissioners,
8 to be paid to the employees of the maintenance or cleaning contractor.
