An Act to protect the Commonwealth from toxic chemicals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the commissioner of the  
2   department of environmental protection shall include per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances under  
3   the definition of Toxic or Hazardous Substance as defined under 301 CMR 41.02 and 301 CMR  
4   41.03.
