Observations and Recommendations

- 1. The inmate population was 82 at the time of inspection.
- 2. At the time of the inspection, the medical waste shipping log was provided to CSP staff for review during the pre-inspection meeting.
- 3. Hot water temperature range for handwash sinks is 110°F to 130°F.
- 4. Hot water temperature range for showers is 100°F to 112°F.
- 5. During the COVID-19 pandemic, there have been several changes made to the conduct of inspections for the CSP. One of the changes made includes reducing the amount of time CSP inspectors spend at one facility during an inspection. During the most recent inspection of your facility, the CSP conducted an abbreviated inspection of your facility focusing on those areas that have historically shown up on past reports, as well as areas of high concern for health and safety. The focused inspection was conducted in an effort to reduce COVID-19 exposure to facility staff, inmates, and CSP inspectors, and because of this, the inspection report is significantly shortened. We hope to return to standard inspectional procedures soon.

This facility does not comply with the Department's Regulations cited above. In accordance with 105 CMR 451.404, please submit a plan of correction within 10 working days of receipt of this notice, indicating the specific corrective steps to be taken, a timetable for such steps, and the date by which correction will be achieved. The plan should be signed by the Superintendent or Administrator and submitted to my attention, at the address listed above.
