

Senate, November 8, 2021 -- (Filed by Mr. Rodrigues) Order relative to procedures to be followed when considering the House Bill relative to immediate COVID-19 recovery needs (House, No. 4234).

1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the House
2 Bill relative to immediate COVID-19 recovery needs (House, No. 4234) (the committee on
3 Ways and Means having recommended that the bill be amended by striking out all after the
4 enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text of Senate document numbered 2564) shall
5 be considered for a second reading on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 and shall be the only
6 item on the calendar.

7 Upon adoption of this order, only redrafted and further amendments shall be in order. All
8 amendments filed prior to this order and all redrafted and further amendments shall be second
9 reading-amendments to the Senate Ways and Means new text (Senate, No. 2564), but further
10 amendments in the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further
11 specify the procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

12 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
13 time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no
14 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
15 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
