**Re: Interception of Wire and Oral Communications for 2021**  
**Pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 272, Section 99**

Dear Clerk Hurley:

Please be advised that there were one (1) interception of wire or oral communications under M.G.L. Chapter 272, Section 99, applied for by this office during the calendar year 2021.


Pursuant to the Annual Report of interceptions, M.G.L. Chapter 272, Section 99R, this office reports the following:

That during the course of one (1) ongoing narcotics investigation:

- (1) There were four (4) applications made for warrants during the 2021 calendar year.
- (2) Second Assistant District Attorney Sharon Thibeault and Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Bright were the applicants.
- (3) There were four (4) warrants issued.
- (4) The effective period for the warrants was from 5/6/2021 to 7/30/2021 which includes the consecutive original time frames and the two extensions.
- (5) The designated offenses on the initial warrant and the additional extensions were:
  1. G.L. c.94C §32 Class A (fentanyl) distribution and possession with intent to distribute.
  2. G.L. c.94C §32A Class B (cocaine) distribution and possession with intent to distribute.
  3. G.L. c.94C §32E Trafficking controlled substances
  4. G.L. c.94C §40 Conspiracy to commit above/in violation of
    - a. The number of renewals was two (2).

- b. The number of interceptions during the warrant and extension period was 32,383.
- c. Twelve (12) defendants were arrested on a total of 14 criminal charges as a result of the overall investigation which included the interceptions. Defendants are currently only charged in District Court. Some Grand Jury presentments for indictments are expected in the future.
- d. The charges against these defendants remain pending and thus no criminal convictions have resulted from the investigation involving these interceptions.
