**Programs (Reentry and Violence Prevention):** The Reentry Program and the Violence Prevention Program were not up and running from December 6, 2021 until March 7, 2022 due to the pandemic. FN-1 continues to house pre-trial inmates. The Reentry Program which was once located in Unit C-1 to work with sentenced inmates within 6 months to release is still operating as a quarantine unit for new commitments. Upon return to normal operations on March 7, 2022, the Reentry staff conducted LSCMI's, intake and exit interviews, program/sober house placements, and any needed wrap-around services on an individual basis for those close to release.
