This proposed FY22 spending plan incorporates several assumptions and changes within SRBTF operations including-

- The renewal of the legal services contract with MHTL provides budgeting consistency going forward, holding spending on legal services flat.
- Holding administrative costs flat to accommodate possible turnover.
- An increase in D\&O/Fiduciary insurance costs to give additional negotiating flexibility given recent market fluctuations as demonstrated by the most recent renewal.
- An increased yearly amount for OPEB valuation work required by M.G.L. c.32A §24(g) overseen by the Comptroller's office based on a requisition under statewide contract PRF56.
