1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the Senate
2 Bill relative to forfeiture reform (Senate, No. 2671), to be reported by the committee on Ways
3 and Means with a recommended new draft with the same title (Senate, No. 2944), on Friday,
4 June 17, 2022, and read into the Senate Journal on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, shall be placed in the
5 Orders of the Day for a second reading on Thursday, June 23, 2022.

6 All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
7 5:00 P.M, on Tuesday, June 21, 2022. All such amendments shall be second reading-
8 amendments to the Senate Ways and Means new draft (Senate, No. 2944), but further
9 amendments in the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further
10 specify the procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

11 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
12 time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no

- 13 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
- 14 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
