Ordered, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the House
Bill relative to Massachusetts's transportation resources and climate (House, No. 4916) (the
committee on Ways and Means having recommended that the bill be amended by striking out all
after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text of Senate document numbered
2989) shall be placed in the Orders of the Day for a second reading on Thursday, July 14, 2022.

All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
5:00 P.M, on Monday, July 11, 2022. All such amendments shall be second reading-amendments
to the Senate Ways and Means new text (Senate, No. 2989), but further amendments in the third
degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further specify the procedure and
format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.
