1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the Senate
2 Bill to expand access to high-quality, affordable early education and care (Senate, No. 2883), to
3 be reported by the committee on Ways and Means with a recommended new draft with the same
4 title (Senate, No. 2973), shall be placed in the Orders of the Day for a second reading on
5 Thursday, July 7, 2022.

6 All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
7 3:00 P.M, on Tuesday, July 5, 2022. All such amendments shall be second reading-amendments
8 to the Senate Ways and Means new draft (Senate, No. 2973), but further amendments in the third
9 degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further specify the procedure and
10 format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

11 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third
12 time and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no

- 13 amendments shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the
- 14 committee on Bills in the Third Reading.
