1 *Ordered*, That notwithstanding Senate Rule 7 or any other rule to the contrary, the House
2 Bill expanding protections for reproductive rights (House, No. 4954) (Ms. Friedman having
3 recommended that the bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting
4 in place thereof the text of Senate document numbered 2996) shall be placed in the Orders of the
5 Day for a second reading on Wednesday, July 13, 2022.

6 All amendments shall be filed electronically in the office of the Clerk of the Senate by
7 5:00 P.M., on Tuesday, July 12, 2022. All such amendments shall be second-reading
8 amendments to the proposed new text (Friedman) (Senate, No. 2996), but further amendments in
9 the third degree to such amendments shall be in order. The Clerk shall further specify the
10 procedure and format for filing all amendments, consistent with this order.

11 After the bill as amended is ordered to a third reading, it shall immediately be read a third time
12 and the question shall then immediately be on passing it to be engrossed, and no amendments

- 13 shall be in order at the third reading of the bill unless recommended by the committee on Bills in
- 14 the Third Reading.
