An Act designating March 5 as United States Navy Seabees Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15SSSSSS
2 the following section:-

3 Section 15TTTTTT. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
4 March 5 as United States Navy Seabees Day in recognition of the birthday of the United States
5 Naval Construction Battalion, better known as the Navy Seabees, on March 5, 1942, which was
6 an innovation of military minds during World War Two having a dual mission to build and to
7 fight in support of combat operations, humanitarian outreach and nation-building, and
8 recommending that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
