An Act relative to eliminating surcharges for vehicle inspection violations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 7A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3 A penalty imposed for a violation of this section shall not be considered a moving  
4 violation for the purpose of determining insurance surcharges on motor vehicle premiums  
5 pursuant to Section 113B of Chapter 175.

6 SECTION 2. Section 7V of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
7 inserting at the end thereof the following:-

8 A penalty imposed for a violation of this section shall not be considered a moving  
9 violation for the purpose of determining insurance surcharges on motor vehicle premiums  
10 pursuant to Section 113B of Chapter 175.
