# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing pregnancy as a qualifying event.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, in addition to
2	any qualifying event under federal law, rule, or regulation that makes one eligible for a special
3	enrollment period for enrollment in a qualified health plan in the state health insurance exchange
4	established pursuant to the federal patient protection and affordable care act, the state health
5	insurance exchange shall allow for the enrollment of a pregnant individual within 30 days
6	following the commencement of the pregnancy; provided however, that the pregnancy is
7	certified by a licensed health care provider, as defined in chapter 112 of the general laws. Upon
8	such enrollment, any qualified health plan in the state health insurance exchange shall ensure that
9	coverage is effective on the first day of the month in which said certification is received.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
