An Act relative to insurance surcharges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "incident" in line 227, the
- 3 following sentence:- Driving a motor vehicle which has an expired inspection sticker shall not be
- 4 considered a surchargeable incident.
