An Act relative to gender identity in insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

| 1 | SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 |

| 4 | "Gender identity" shall mean a person's gender-related identity, appearance or behavior, |
| 5 | whether or not that gender-related identity, appearance or behavior is different from that |
| 6 | traditionally associated with the person's physiology or assigned sex at birth. Gender-related |
| 7 | identity may be shown by providing evidence including, but not limited to, medical history, care |
| 8 | or treatment of the gender-related identity, consistent and uniform assertion of the gender-related |
| 9 | identity or any other evidence that the gender-related identity is sincerely held as part of a |
| 10 | person's core identity; provided, however, that gender-related identity shall not be asserted for |
| 11 | any improper purpose. |
