Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 40 of chapter 176 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 41, the words "twenty-five percent of such excess" and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- 10 percent of assets.
