In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to add a compulsory death benefit to automobile liability insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 109, by inserting after the words "such a policy" the
- 3 following:- "provided, however, that in instances of death to a person survived by a minor child,
- 4 spouse, or dependent parent, said limit shall not be less than \$100,000 per decedent, which
- 5 amount shall not be subject to any liens".
