## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to accessibility at gas stations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the Office
2	on Disability is hereby directed and authorized to conduct a comprehensive study to investigate
3	accessibility to gas pumps at gas stations. Said study shall include, but not be limited to,
4	compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act's assistance at self-service gas station
5	guidelines. The Office on Disability shall provide an opportunity for interested parties to submit
6	relevant testimony. The Office on Disability shall file a report of its study, including
7	recommendations and drafts of any legislation, if necessary, with the clerks of the Senate and
8	House of Representatives within one year of the effective date of this act.
