*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 10A of chapter 255D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official  
2   Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “buyer”, in line 5, the following words:- ,  
3   unless a device to convert cash into a prepaid card with no fee is readily accessible at the  
4   establishment
