**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act protecting children from domestic violence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13A of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3 “(d) Whoever commits an assault or an assault and battery upon another within a
4 dwelling and in the presence of a child under 16 years of age shall be punished by imprisonment
5 in the state prison for not more than 5 years or in the house of correction for not more than 2½
6 years, or by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Furthermore,
7 the law enforcement agency filing the charges shall provide the department of social services, as
8 established in chapter 18B, with a notice of the charges, to be used at the department’s
9 discretion.”
