An Act to extend statute of limitations for incest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. The second paragraph of Section 63 of Chapter 277, is hereby amended to provide as follows: -

Notwithstanding the first paragraph, if a victim of a crime set forth in section 13B, 13F, $13 \mathrm{H}, 22,22 \mathrm{~A}, 23,24 \mathrm{~B}, 26 \mathrm{~A}$ or 50 of chapter 265 , or section $1,2,3,4,4 \mathrm{~A}, 4 \mathrm{~B}, 5,6,7,8,12,13$, $26,28,29 \mathrm{~A}, 29 \mathrm{~B}, 33,34,35$ or 35 A of chapter 272 is under the age of 16 at the time the crime is committed, or, if a victim of section 17 of chapter 272 is under the age of 18 at the time the crime is committed, the period of limitation for prosecution shall not commence until the victim has reached the age of 16 (or has reached age 18 if a victim of section 17 of chapter 272) or the violation is reported to a law enforcement agency, whichever occurs earlier.
