An Act bringing the crime of leaving the scene of personal injury causing death within the jurisdiction of the district court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 26 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 official edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “subparagraph (1) of paragraph (a) of  
3 subdivision (1) of section twenty-four,” in lines 11-12, the following words:- subparagraph (2) of  
4 paragraph (a<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of subdivision (2) of section twenty-four,
