#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act to protect employees of DCF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 13M the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 (a) A person shall not by words or conduct knowingly:
- 4 (1) threaten an employee of Department of Children & Families; and as a result of the
- 5 threat, place the other person in reasonable belief of death or serious bodily injury.
- 6 (b) A person who violates subsection (a) of this section shall be imprisoned not more than
- 7 two years or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 8 (c) A person who violates subsection (a) of this section with the intent to prevent another
- 9 person from reporting to the Department for Children and Families the suspected abuse or

- neglect of a child shall be imprisoned not more than two years or fined not more than \$1,000.00,
- 11 or both.
