In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)

An Act providing benefits for permanent functional loss and disfigurement under the Worker's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section $36(k)$ of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3 , the words "fifteen thousand dollars" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 30 times the average weekly wage in the commonwealth as determined pursuant to subsection (a) of section 29 of chapter 151 A . and by striking out in lines 4-6 the words "No amount shall be payable under this section for disfigurement that is purely scarbased, unless such disfigurement is on the face, neck or hands."
