An Act protecting an employee's right to rebuttal of personnel records.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 148A of Chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first sentence the  
3 following, “or under the personnel records provisions in Section 52C of this chapter.”

4           Section 150 of said Chapter 149 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the  
5 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the second paragraph by inserting after “33E” the  
6 following, “52C”
