An Act relative to labor rights of chief probation officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking the phrase “, or chief probation officer or acting chief  
3 probation officer of any court or region, including without limitation of the term, any division or  
4 department of the trial court”.
