An Act relative to establishing a prevailing wage for security officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 27H of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 1 and 2, the words “the cleaning and
3 maintenance of” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- cleaning and maintenance
4 or security guard services in.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 27H of said chapter 149, as so appearing, is hereby further
6 amended by striking out, in line 6, the words “maintenance or cleaning” and inserting in place
7 thereof the following words:- cleaning and maintenance or security guard.
