**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act regulating the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in providing mental health services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 123 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 36C the following section:

3 Section 1: Purpose

4 The purpose of this act is to regulate the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in providing
5 mental health services in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in order to ensure the safety and
6 well-being of individuals seeking mental health treatment, while also allowing for the
7 responsible use of AI in mental health services.

8 Section 2: Definitions

9 (a) "Artificial Intelligence" or "AI" means any technology that can simulate human
10 intelligence, including but not limited to, natural language processing, training language models,
11 reinforcement learning from human feedback and machine learning systems.

12 (b) "Mental health services" means any service provided by a licensed mental health
13 professional for the purpose of diagnosing, treating, or preventing mental illness or emotional or
14 behavioral disorders.

15 (c) "Licensed mental health professional" means any individual who is licensed by the
16 state of Massachusetts to provide mental health services, including but not limited to,
17 psychiatrists, psychologists, licensed mental health counselors (LMHCs), licensed independent
18 clinical social workers (LICSWs) and other professional counselors.

19 Section 3: Regulation of AI in Mental Health Services

20 (a) Any licensed mental health professional who wishes to provide mental health services
21 through the use of AI shall first seek approval from the relevant professional licensing board.

22 (b) Any AI system used to provide mental health services must be designed to prioritize
23 the safety and well-being of individuals seeking treatment and must be continuously monitored
24 by a licensed mental health professional to ensure its safety and effectiveness.

25 (c) Any licensed mental health professional providing mental health services through the
26 use of AI shall inform patients of the use of AI in their treatment and provide them with the
27 option to receive treatment from a licensed mental health professional.

28 (d) Any licensed mental health professional providing mental health services through the
29 use of AI shall disclose the use of AI to patients in advance and obtain their informed consent.

30 Section 4: Penalties

31 (a) Any licensed mental health professional who violates the provisions of this act shall
32 be subject to disciplinary action by the relevant professional licensing board.
