**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the use of electronic benefit transfer cards with regard to online grocery delivery services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 18 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after Section 2 part (D) the following:-

3 (E) (a) For the purposes of this section, the following words shall have the following
4 meanings:-

5 “Online Grocery Delivery Service”, a brick-and-mortar supermarket or grocery store that
6 allows online ordering, or a standalone e-commerce service that includes grocery items.

7 (b) The department shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement the use of the
8 electronic benefit transfer card for online grocery delivery services.
