### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act preserving access to hospital services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of section 51G the following new section:
- 3 (7) The department, in conjunction with other state departments or agencies, shall
- 4 promulgate regulations creating a process for state receivership for any hospital or free-standing
- 5 clinic that provides essential health services and (a) closes without providing the required 90-day
- 6 notice or (b) closes a hospital or free-standing clinic following a determination by the department
- 7 that a closure would constitute a discontinuation of services necessary for preserving access and
- 8 health status in the hospital or free-standing clinic's service area. These regulations shall include
- 9 a mechanism and source for funding said receivership.
