In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to postpartum depression screenings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 10N the following: -
- 3 Section 100. The division shall provide coverage of screenings by pediatricians for
- 4 postpartum depression in mothers of newly born children during any visit to a pediatrician's
- 5 office taking place for up to one year from the date of the child's birth.
