An Act respecting autonomy in name choice for newly married partners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 1D and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3 Section 1D . Each party to a marriage may adopt any surname, for example the present  
4 or birth-given surname of either party, a previously-used birth-given surname, or any hyphenated  
5 combination. Each party to a marriage may also adopt any first name, middle name or any other  
6 name.
