**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to protecting our waterways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 90B of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
2 amended, in the first paragraph, by inserting after the words “ by members of the state police,”
3 the following: “by deputy sheriffs”

4 SECTION 2. Section 10G of Chapter 21A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
5 hereby amended, in the first paragraph, by inserting after the words “members of the state
6 police,” the following: “deputy sheriffs”
