In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to a retirement buyback issue.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the
2	contrary, the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System shall credit Diane Galanti, a member
3	of the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System, with creditable service for the period of
4	December 12, 1988 to June 30, 1999, inclusive, for the purpose of determining her
5	superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of
6	chapter 32 of the General Laws. Before the date that any retirement allowance becomes effective
7	in the case of Diane Galanti, she shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the retirement system
8	in one (1) sum or installments, upon such terms and conditions as the board may prescribe, an
9	amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from her regular
10	compensation for such previous service, plus buyback interest.
