An Act increasing the police and fire retirement age from 65 to 67.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 415 of the Acts of 1987 is hereby amended by striking  
2 the word “sixty-five” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- “sixty-seven”.

3           SECTION 2. Section 1 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
4 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the figure “65”, in line 329, and inserting in place  
5 thereof the following figure:- “67”.
