Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary,

5 Section 2. Chapter 32 Section 94B (2) of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014

6 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 31 after the word compensation the

7 following words, in the event that such person retires in accordance with this section any

8 secondary cancer shall be covered in accordance with section 9 of this chapter.
