**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court  
(2023-2024)**

An Act providing for a fair and equitable Group 4 retirement benefit for police officers working on Massachusetts public higher education campuses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 297, after the word "Authority;" the  
3   following:-  
4           “any campus police officer employed at a Massachusetts state college, university,  
5   community college and the University of Massachusetts”
