An Act amending retirement benefits for certain employees of the parole board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Group 4 paragraph (g) of sub-division 2 of section 3 of chapter 32, as  
2 amended by section (1) of Chapter 71 of the acts of 2006, is hereby further amended by inserting  
3 after the words "supervising prison camp officer," the following words:-- "transitional parole  
4 officer I, II, III."
