Resolve authorizing the study of cost of living increases for state police retirees.

1 **Resolved**, That there shall be a special commission to examine the feasibility of increases
2 to Cost of Living Adjustments for retirees of the Massachusetts State Police. The commission
3 shall consist of the chairs of the joint committee on public service, the executive director of the
4 state retirement board, a member to be appointed by the chair of the MA public employee
5 retirement administration commission and the president of MA retirees.

6 Said commission shall report to the house and senate committees on ways and means the
7 results of its investigation recommendations together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
8 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerks of the house of
9 representatives and senate on or before January 1, 2024.
