**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to injured and incapacitated state-employed police officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph:-

3 “Sixtieth “Police officer”, “policeman”, or “permanent member of a police force”, shall
4 include without limitation, any police officer appointed by the University of Massachusetts,
5 Environmental police, Massport police, and campus police officers of the state colleges and
6 universities.

7 SECTION 2. Section 94 of chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
8 after the words “Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority,” the following words:- or of the
9 University of Massachusetts police department, Environmental police, Massport police, and
10 campus police officers of the state colleges and universities.

11 SECTION 3. Section 111F of chapter 41 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
12 inserting after the word:- “General Edward Lawrence Logan International Airport, and members

13 of the Massachusetts military reservation fire department, for the purposes of this section the
14 Massachusetts Port Authority and Massachusetts military reservation shall be fire districts,” the
15 following:- The provisions of this section shall also apply in all aspects to any University of
16 Massachusetts police officer, Environmental police, Massport police, and campus police officer
17 of the state colleges and universities
