**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to Massachusetts certified emergency telecommunicators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, subsection (g)
2 of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by inserting after the words “Cushing hospital” in lines 265 and 266 the
4 following:-

5 "all full time dispatchers, dispatch supervisors, communications center directors or
6 communications chiefs certified by the commonwealth of Massachusetts State 911 Department
7 as certified telecommunicators, as defined by MA 560 CMR 5.04"
