An Act relative to electronic monitoring department personnel pension group classification.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 106. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, assistant  
4 coordinators of the electric monitoring department of the office of probation shall be eligible for  
5 classification as members of pension group 2 by the Massachusetts state board of retirement  
6 pursuant to section 3.
