An Act relative to retirement benefits for county correctional nurses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended by section 27 of  
2 chapter 39 of the acts of 2021, is hereby further amended by inserting, in line 274, after the word  
3 “facilities”, the following words: - and except any position explicitly classified in another group.

4           SECTION 2. Said section 3 of said chapter 32, as so amended, is hereby further amended  
5 by inserting, in line 331, after the words “assistant deputy superintendent”, the following words:-  
6 registered nurse, medication-assisted treatment nurse manager, psychiatric nurse, psychology  
7 nurse practitioner, director of nursing, licensed practical nurse, nurse practitioner or paramedic.
