# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act providing that officers in all positions of the Falmouth Police Department subject to Chapter 31 of the General Laws shall be exempt from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, officers in all
2	positions of the police department of the town of Falmouth subject to Chapter 31 of the General
3	Laws shall be exempt from the civil service law.
4	SECTION 2. Section 1 shall not impair the civil service status of an officer employed on
5	a permanent basis in a civil service position in the police department of the town of Falmouth on
6	the effective date of this act.
7	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
